Grandmother Irene Queen is quite literally living up to her name by being crowned Granny of the Month by Grannynet, a community-based website for grandmothers.

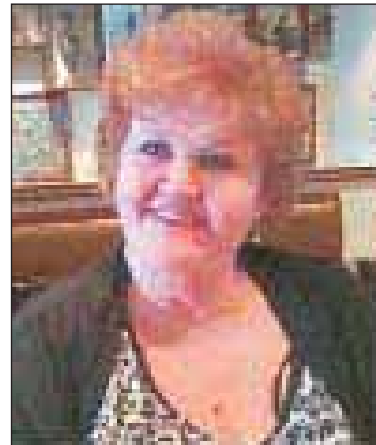
